FINAL STATEMENT OF REASONS

Hearing Date: September 28, 2011

Subject Matter of Proposed Regulations: Comprehensive Intern Development Program (CIDP)

Section Affected: Amend Sections 109, 116, 117, and 121 of Title 16, Division 2 of the California Code of Regulations

Updated Information

The Initial Statement of Reasons is included in the file. The information contained therein was updated as follows:

- The Board issued a 15-day Notice of Availability of Modified Initial Statement of Reasons (ISR) and Documents Added to the Rulemaking File to the file. The Amended ISR expanded the Factual Basis/Rationale section to include additional historical details and additional documents were added under Underlying Data to include a copy of the IDP Comparison Chart, Draft Meeting Summary for the Professional Qualifications Committee, and an excerpt of the June 16, 2011, Board Meeting Minutes with the file.

Local Mandate

A mandate is not imposed on local agencies or school districts.

Small Business Impact

The proposed regulatory action will not have a significant adverse economic impact directly affecting business, including the ability of California businesses to compete with business in other states, because it affects only architect applicants.

Consideration of Alternatives

No reasonable alternative which was considered or that has otherwise been identified and brought to the attention of the Board would be either more effective in carrying out the purpose for which the action is proposed or would be as effective and less burdensome to affected private persons than the proposed regulation.

Objections or Recommendations/Responses

There were no objections or recommendations regarding the proposed action.
