FINAL STATEMENT OF REASONS

Hearing Date: August 3, 2015

Subject Matter of Proposed Regulations: Application for Eligibility Evaluation (AEE)

Section Affected: Title 16, California Code of Regulations (CCR), Sections 109 and 111

Updated Information

The Initial Statement of Reasons is included in the file. The information contained therein is updated as follows:

The following additional explanatory information is provided:

Existing law, Business and Professions Code (BPC) section 5550.5 (Assembly Bill 1822, Berryhill, Chapter 317, Statutes of 2012), authorizes the Architects Board (Board) to accept a Federal tax identification number (TIN) in lieu of a social security number (SSN).

Existing law, BPC section 30) (Senate Bill 1159, Lara, Chapter 752, Statutes of 2014), requires the Board to require an applicant for licensure to provide either an individual TIN or SSN if the applicant is an individual.

In order to be compliant with existing law, the Board, in redesigning the AEE, has provided a section for an applicant to provide either an ITIN or SSN. The Board only licenses applicants, and has provided an ITIN rather than a TIN to note that it is an individual tax identification number.

Local Mandate

A mandate is not imposed on local agencies or school districts.

Small Business Impact

This regulation will not have a significant adverse economic impact on small business.

Anticipated Benefits of This Regulatory Action

Updating the AEE will restructure the layout to be in accordance with web accessibility standards for online forms; allow candidates to identify if they have been honorably discharged from the United States Armed Forces, and therefore eligible for expedited processing; and clarify Board processing times for the AEE.

Consideration of Alternatives

No reasonable alternative which was considered or that has otherwise been identified and brought to the attention of the Board would be more effective in carrying out the purpose for which it was proposed or would be as effective and less burdensome to affected private persons than the adopted regulation or would be more cost effective to affected private persons and equally effective in implementing the statutory policy or other provision of law.

Objections or Recommendations/Responses

There were no objections or recommendations regarding the proposed action.

Incorporated by Reference

Due to size and particular formatting requirements, the complete three (3) page Application for Eligibility Evaluation would be cumbersome and impractical to publish in the CCR.
